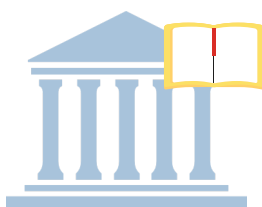

The ATC is tasked to monitor the implementation of the ASEAN Declaration on Human Resource Development and related Roadmap.

Reporting Mechanism

The council shall **meet at least once a year**.

ASEAN Labour Ministers Meeting (**ALMM**); and
ASEAN Economic Ministers Meeting (**AEM**)
